Robin Brett called meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

A report on the forthcoming Davos Meeting was given by Peter Signer and Rudolf [sic] Schultz. The dates of the forthcoming meeting are August 27 to August 31, 1973, Davos, Switzerland. Three separate mailing announcements of the Meeting will be made and the first announcement is presently being mailed. John Wasson read a summary of exchanges between McCrosky and himself concerning the IAU Commission Committee #22 for a Commission on Meteorite Nomenclature. John Wasson moved: "I move that a "Committee on Meteorite Nomenclature" be established. The Committee will consist of the following five person:

the editor of the Meteoritical Bulletin,
 the editor of the British Museum catalog,
 a person from the Eastern Hemisphere engaged in the field recovery of meteorites,
 a person from the Western Hemisphere engages in the field recovery of meteorites, and
 one additional meteoriticist.

Members 3, 4, and 5 will be appointed by the president of the Meteoritical Society with the advice and consent of the president of I.A.U. Commission #22. The Meteoritical Society recognizes the importance of cooperation with local scientific organizations in selection of names, and instructs the committee to consider the advice of such organizations." The motion was seconded and passed by a vote of 6 for, zero against.

Ursula Marvin presented the Treasurer's report.

Carleton Moore asked for a brief summary of approved nomenclature for meteorites. Such a summary would be printed in an issue of Meteoritics for all workers to be able to follow so that the nomenclature of meteorite [illegible]s will be consistent in each issue of Meteoritics. President Brett appointed C. B. Moore, R. Van Schmus and J. Wasson to assist in preparing the style sheet on nomenclature.

John Wasson entered the motion: "The President of the Meteoritical Society should contact Bevan French and suggest the appointment of a cosmochemist to the NSF Earth Sciences Panel." The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.
